women and are in the company until the loading or unloading process ends and they Better yet, they do it all with a smile on their face.

They told us about the impact of the last cyclone and how the seawater reached their chests inside their houses, but nothing deterred them. Its director, Arístides Feraudys Freinosa - who at that time was Vice President of the Assembly - was closely involved in the task of proceeding with the process of unloading and distributing mattresses for those affected (a total of 600 mattresses were delivered, free of charge, to the vulnerable. and for a reasonable price to the rest of the population).

These beautiful people give a little more of themselves every day, to turn Batabanó and the Isle of Youth into areas longed for by those who leave them behind in search of other life projects and the best little corner of the earth for those who live there every day. For them, our respect and admiration for believing in a better Cuba.
